

Table 3. Museums directly associated with Roman ancient monuments

This table includes museums that have a collection of archaeological finds that is entirely or fairly substantially derived from a Roman site in close proximity to the museum; excluding museums with multi-period collections derived from widespread sites, including the British Museum, The National Museum of Scotland, The National Museum of Wales and most county museums. The information is derived from the Internet and from visits to most of these sites by Richard Hingley and Kate Sharpe in 2016 to 2024.
