Wife of Frederick Michael Macleod Forster (married 1945), Sudan Political Service 1939 - 1955, as follows:

1940-1945	Governor- General's temporary commission as Bimbashi, S.D.F. (Eritrea, Ethiopia, Libya)
1945-1948	A.D.C./D.C. Raga, Equatoria
1948	D.C. Raga, Bahr al- Ghazal
1948-1951	D.C. Port Sudan, Kassala
1951-1954	Private Secretary to Governor-General
1954-1955	Deputy Governor Kassala
1955	Retired

## 1. Trek Diaries

- SAD.761/9/1-3 1946 Sep 25  
Diary of a journey by lorry from Wau to Aweil to hold an enquiry into a case of murder. Numerous delays due to heavy rain and the resulting condition of the road
- SAD.761/9/4-8 1946 Oct 10-29  
Diary of a journey by lorry from Wau to Deim Zubayr, stopping at Khor Gunna resthouse. Inspection of R.C. Mission school there. Later stops at Khar Gamus and Kura resthouses
- SAD.761/9/9-11 1946 Dec 6-13  
Account of a walking trek along the Biri river with Mr and Mrs J.N. Jewitt to report on the suitability of the area as a site for the resettlement of the Kreich tribes. Witnessed eclipse of the moon at Kuru. Walking commenced at Deim Zubayr and continued along the left bank of the Biri
- SAD.761/9/12-13 1946  
Account of Christmas in Raga including a trek at dawn to view game. Encounter with a honeyguide bird
