1. Diaries and Trek Notes

SAD.427/5/1-194 1902 Jan 1 - Dec 31

Diary written by R.V. Savile during his service in Kassala Province, based at Gedaref (SAD.427/5/2-80) and Kassala (SAD.427/5/81-167) and travelling throughout the surrounding areas

SAD.427/5/2-183 Main body of the diary, covering R.V. Savile's service - inspection of crops, administration (particularly post work) and trying civil / criminal court cases - as well as everyday life, visits from colleagues, shooting, journeys undertaken, the weather, dinners with / inspection of the XI Sudanese (from SAD.427/5/81 forward) and so on. Specific entries include R.V. Savile's receipt of official intimation of transfer to civil service and appointment to 1st Class Magistrate while at Gedaref (SAD.427/5/16) and his part in a well-sinking between Kassala and Goz Regeb (SAD.427/5/161-163). Also covered is a trip to sketch the country between Gallabat and the Setit river (SAD.427/5/165-183), with orders to make suggestions about the Abyssinian frontier in a report before meeting the frontier commission on 1 Jan 1903 (SAD.427/5/168). Information is also given about an Abyssinian raid (SAD.427/5/183). The diary closes with R.V. Savile due to meet the frontier commission in Gallabat the following day (SAD.427/5/183)

The final pages contain notes in Arabic (SAD.427/5/184), general notes, including a list of provisions and details of cases tried, (SAD.427/5/184-185), addresses (SAD.427/5/185), accounts, wages and other rough notes (SAD.427/5/186-194) and a list of photographs taken on the Abyssinian frontier trip (SAD.427/5/193)

SAD.427/2/1-23 1902 Dec 1 - Dec 23

Diary / report of trek along the Sudan-Abyssinian frontier, from Kassala to Gallabat via the Setit river. The purpose of the trip was to give advice to the frontier commission responsible for delimitation of the border. The diary is an expanded version of SAD.427/5/168-179, with a map sketch of the proposed frontier included in the front cover (SAD.427/2/1). It opens with R.V. Savile's orders, received before leaving Kassala (SAD.427/2/2) and gives a full account of the trek, including details of travel, hunting, events en route and people encountered. Entries contain information such as extra men being assembled for the trek due to the threat of Abyssinian raiders (SAD.427/2/5-6) and a visit from Mase Dari, an Italian dealer in wild animals (SAD.427/2/18) [Note: daily]

Trek diary written during R.V. Savile's service in Kassala Province, following chronologically from SAD.427/5

SAD.427/4/1 Rough notes: list of place names; accounts for livestock

List of types of animal, horn measurements and numbers allowed to be, and actually, shot

SAD.427/4/3

Compass bearings from points on Atbara (left and right banks) and the summit of Tabarakalla SAD.427/4/4-48.59-65 The main body of the diary, with Sundays separate at the back (SAD.427/4/59-65). It begins as R.V. Savile meets the Abyssinian delegates to the frontier commission in Gallabat (SAD.427/4/4), and the first section gives details of R.V. Savile's trek with C.W. Gwynn, D.S.O., Surveys Department, along the Sudan-Abyssinian border, to the Setit river and back (SAD.427/4/4-12, 59-60), then to the Rahad river and back (SAD.427/4/12-13, 59-60) to undertake survey work, map sketching and beaconing of the frontier. The diary also contains information about a visit to the province by R. von Slatin, Inspector-General (SAD.427/4/14-18, 60-61), R.V. Savile's trip to take the Camel Corps to Gedaref (SAD.427/4/15-17, 60-61), crop inspection (SAD.427/4/20), Bayram celebrations, including sports arranged by R.V. Savile (SAD.427/4/22-23, 61-62), and visitors, trying cases and travel arrangements are mentioned throughout. An account is given of a tribute-collecting tour on the Gash in Northern Kassala, from Gamman to Goz Regeb and back to Kassala (SAD.427/4/29-39, 62-64), and the diary ends with R.V. Savile's journey to Egypt to go on leave (SAD.427/4/44-48, 64-65) [Notes: daily; see also SAD.427/3 for an expanded account of

SAD.427/3/1-51 1903 Apr 4 - May 10

> Diary of a tribute-collecting tour of Northern Kassala on the Gash river (an expanded version of SAD.427/4/29-39, 62-64) describing travel arrangements, the collection of tribute, counting of flocks and confiscation of animals from villagers in lieu of tribute payment, encounters with local people / incidents occurring en route and hunting. R.V. Savile was assisting A.G. Dwyer with the tour by visiting the northern part of the district, going from Gamman (SAD.427/3/2) to Goz Regeb (SAD.427/3/49) and back to Kassala (SAD.427/3/51). Places visited include Tendelai (SAD.427/3/2), Godamaieb (SAD.427/3/10), Er Risai (SAD.427/3/20), Bashui [?Bashut] (SAD.427/3/29), Tendera (SAD.427/3/41) and Umm Beibar (SAD.427/3/48). R.V. Savile provides a glossary of Arabic terms used at the beginning of the diary (SAD.427/3/1) [Note: daily]

SAD.427/4/29-39, 62-641

SAD.427/6/1-125 1903 Oct 1 - 1905 Nov 29

Diary following chronologically from SAD.427/4, written during R.V. Savile's service as ADC in Kassala Province. Details include R.V. Savile's return from leave (SAD.427/6/2-11), establishing a post at T`aalia (SAD.427/6/14-22), tours to collect tribute and count flocks at Gulsa (SAD.427/6/24-26) and on the Gash river (SAD.427/6/28-34), sports at Kassala (SAD.427/6/47-49), leave (SAD.427/6/67-68), treks to lay out (SAD.427/6/76) then inspect (SAD.427/6/81-82) the Abu Gamal - Umbrega road, prospecting for a trade route, T`hamyam to Kassala (SAD.427/6/83-93), trekking to T`hamyam with F.R. Wingate, the Sirdar (SAD.427/6/97-100) and trekking to Tisarara to start well-sinkers at work (SAD.427/6/120-121). Other information relates to playing polo, visits from colleagues, office work, trying cases, hunting and shooting, crop inspection and various surveying trips and treks in the area

SAD.427/7/1-150 1910 Jan 15 - 1921 Jun 19

Diary of R.V. Savile's travels in Kordofan and Darfur, containing descriptions of treks and tours, not maintained between travels. Section SAD.427/7/2-63 relates to Kordofan and SAD.427/7/64-149 to Darfur

SAD.427/7/2-28 1910 Jan 15 - Mar 8

Tour in the Western Jebels and Dar Hamr, from El Obeid to Dilling, Kadugli, Talodi, Kerik, Fishik and back to El Obeid, including a punitive visit of the Luman Patrol to Cluppina's village (SAD.427/7/11), interviews with *shaykhs*, watching *dilukas* and hearing complaints

SAD.427/7/28-30 1910 Mar 9 - 13

Field firing and manoeuvres in Jebel Kordofan and the surrounding countryside

SAD.427/7/31-40 1910 Apr 5 - 29

Trek from El Obeid to Tendik via Tegali and back to El Obeid via Koalib, including an unsuccessful punitive attack on Tagoi (SAD.427/7/36-37)

SAD.427/7/41-43 1910 Aug 10 - Sep 2

Trek from El Obeid to Dueim via Taiyara

SAD.427/7/44 1910 Nov 3 - 9

Dueim to El Obeid, with travelling times between stops given

SAD.427/7/45-46 1910 Dec 12 - 26

Trek with R. von Slatin from El Obeid to En Nahud via Dudiya and back via Abu Zabad. Mileages are given

SAD.427/7/47-48 1911 Apr 21 - May 2

El Obeid to Sherkeila via Taiyara and Umm Ruba`a, returning to El Obeid via Umm Ruba`a and the Rahad river

SAD.427/7/48-50 1911 May 15 - 25

El Obeid to Omdurman via Bara and Abu Tabar

SAD.427/7/51 1911 Oct 18 - 23

Kosti to El Obeid, travelling by rail and road

SAD.427/7/52-55 1912 Mar 1 - 17

El Obeid to Tonga with Sir Reginald Wingate, Governor-General and Sirdar, and party, including watching *dilukas*, exchanging gifts and delivery of speeches by the Governor-General at various points on the way. Stops include those at Dilling, Ghulfan, Kadugli and Talodi

SAD.427/7/55-57 1913 Jan 9 - 13

Trek to select a manoeuvre area around El Obeid. Approximate mileages are given and comment made about the inaccuracy of existing maps (SAD.427/7/56)

SAD.427/7/57-63 1915 Dec 30 - 1916 Jan 29

Tour in Western Kordofan with Kelly and A.G. Cummins, beginning and ending at El Obeid and including visits to Abu Zabad, Sinut, El Odaiya and En Nahud and the surrounding area. Entries include descriptions of a reception of Misiriyah 'umdahs and shaykhs and election / installation of a nazir at Abu Zabad (SAD.427/7/58-59), King George's Day celebrations, hearing complaints, trying cases and office work

SAD.427/7/64-69 1917 Jan 3 - 26

Trek from El Obeid to El Fasher to take up the position of Governor of Darfur, travelling via Abu Zabad and En Nahud and visiting / interviewing various *nazirs*, '*umdahs* and *shaykhs*, attending receptions etc. Entries include the parade and races at Abu Zabad, news of R.V. Savile's promotion to Temporary Lieutenant Colonel (SAD.427/7/66) and his arrival into El Fasher, met by the Camel Corps, colleagues, an assembly of *shaykhs*, '*umdahs* and notables and a guard of honour of the XIII Sudanese

SAD.427/7/69-70 1917 Feb 11 - 17

Short trek from El Fasher to Kutum and back, interviewing the *sharati*, hearing a case, shooting and looking at wells en route

SAD.427/7/71-80 1917 Mar 28 - 29

Circular tour to Abu Gabra (SAD.427/7/73), Kalaka, Nyala, Zalingei and Kebkabiya, beginning and ending at El Fasher. Descriptions include hearing complaints / office work and map sketching around Dilu and Dibbis

SAD.427/7/81-89 1918 Apr 1 - May 24

El Fasher to Bahr el Rizeiqat via Abu Gabra and back, including a meeting with a Dinka deputation to settle the boundary (SAD.427/7/84), map sketching, settling shaykhships at Abu Gabra (SAD.427/7/86) and interviewing the *shaykhs* and people at Nyala (SAD.427/7/87)

SAD.427/7/89-93 1918 Jul 11 - Aug 1

Trek from El Fasher to Kutum, Mellit, Umm Keddada and back via Dirra. Descriptions include inspecting No.2 and No.3 Camel Corps Companies in Kutum (SAD.427/7/90), office work, hunting, sketching, interviewing & ayn;umdahs and appointing a new 'umdah in Umm Keddada

SAD.427/7/93-104 1919 Mar 1 - Apr 18

Circular tour to Mellit, Kutum, Kebkabiya, Kereinik, Zalingei and Nyala beginning and ending in El Fasher, during which R.V. Savile visits wells, meets with *shaykhs* etc., undertakes civil work, meets Middleton, P.L. Brocklehurst and Sultan Idris in Kereinik (SAD.427/7/99-100), sketches and takes bearings

SAD.427/7/105-109 1919 Jun 16 - 26

El Fasher to En Nahud, where R.V. Savile makes a triumphal entry, and on to El Obeid by car

SAD.427/7/100-116 1919 Nov 29 - Dec 16

Trek from El Obeid to El Fasher, with details of the journey, stops made and travelling time

SAD.427/7/116-124 1920 Sep 15 - Oct 1

El Fasher to El Obeid via Dirra, Umm Keddada and En Nahud to go on leave

SAD.427/7/124-128 1920 Dec 30 - 1921 Jan 13

El Obeid to El Fasher with R.V. Savile's wife, Evelyn

SAD.427/7/129-145 1921 Mar 28 - May 10

Trek from El Fasher to Kebkabiya, Kereinik, Zalingei, Jebel Marra and back to El Fasher with Evelyn. Details include interviewing *shaykhs* / hearing complaints, shooting, inspecting troops, civil work, discussion of the Nyala - Zalingei boundary (SAD.427/7/138), climbing around the Deriba Lakes (SAD.427/7/140) and descriptions of the countryside / weather

SAD.427/7/146-149 1921 Jun 2 - 19

El Fasher to El Obeid via Abyad and En Nahud, with Evelyn, the latter part of the journey by car

SAD.427/8/1-89 1921 Nov 14 - 1923 Jun 28

Diary of tours in Darfur during R.V. Savile's last years as Governor of the province (SAD.427/8/2-66) and his journey home round Africa (SAD.427/8/67-89) with his wife, Evelyn. The diary was only maintained while on tour, not between travels

SAD.427/8/2-7 1921 Nov 16 - Dec 21

Journey from El Obeid to El Fasher via Umm Keddada (SAD.427/8/5)

SAD.427/8/7-18 1922 May 6 - 27

Trekking holiday in Jebel Marra with Evelyn leaving from El Fasher and going as far as Nyurnia, via Kurra, Turra, and back by the same route. Time during halts is largely spent shooting, walking, and reading

SAD.427/8/18-25 1922 Oct 5 - 20

El Fasher to Kutum and back via Mellit, R.V. Savile doing some work in Kutum, including discussion of Northern Darfur with E.G. Evans (SAD.427/8/22) and in Mellit, including work relating to the frontier commission and hearing cases

SAD.427/8/25-56 1923 Jan 15 - Mar 1

Long tour in Southern Darfur to buy horses for the police and army, beginning and ending in El Fasher and including stops in Sibdu (SAD.427/8/33-36), Nabbagaia (SAD.427/8/39-40), Bodo (SAD.427/8/42-44), Buram (SAD.427/8/48-49) and Nyala (SAD.427/8/52-53). Entries include a Rizeiqat parade and horse show in Sibdu (SAD.427/8/34-36), a Habbaniyah parade and show in Buram (SAD.427/8/48-49), triumphal reception and a guard of honour entering Nyala, followed by races there and meetings in Nyala, to bid farewell to the Nyala *nazirs* and *'umdahs* and a meeting of the defence committee (SAD.427/8/53), and details of hunting / shooting throughout

SAD.427/8/56-65 1923 Jun 3 - 22

Journey from El Fasher to El Obeid (the latter part by car), commencing R.V. Savile's journey home. Contains descriptions of R.V. Savile's send-off at El Fasher, farewells to colleagues and talks to *shavkhs* and `*umdahs*

SAD.427/8/65-85 1923 Jun 23 - Nov 13

Journey out of the Sudan by rail, and home, round Uganda and South Africa. R.V. Savile and party spend some time in Khartoum (SAD.427/8/65-66) and in Port Sudan (SAD.427/8/66-67), then travel via Aden, Mombasa, Nairobi, Entebbe and Kampala, Masindi, Ngora, Nabamali, Jinja and Zanzibar (via Kisumu, Nairobi and Mombasa), and to Mozambique, Beira, Victoria Falls, Bulawayo, Johannesburg, Port Elizabeth and Cape Town. The last part of the journey is via Madeira, arriving London on 13 November 1923
