The blade is probably of Solingen manufacture while the hilt is probably of local Darfur manufacture. The blade is decorated with various inscriptions (some gilded), magic squares (*wafq*) and apotropaic formulae, one of which includes the Sultan's name and the date 1321 [1903/04]. One inscription reads "This is the sword whose name is k.b.h." (meaning not known). The Sultan's name and *tughra* are repeated on the hilt and quillion, with the date 1331 [1913] on the pommel. The name of Abd Al-Rashid is stamped on the scabbard chape
